Learn to make a lavender-filled coaster that will transport you to Provence in July just by putting your hot beverage on it. Turn fusible interfacing into journal covers that are individual works of art. Both projects can be whipped up by the dozens as great gifts for friends and family.

## SUPPLY LIST

### AROMATHERAPY COASTER

- Two 3 ½ inch squares of muslin
- Two 4 ½ inch squares of fabric
- Two 4 ½ inch squares of thin cotton batting
- Dried lavender flowers will be provided for you

### JOURNAL COVER

- Blank journal
- 1 fat quarter fabric for outside of journal
- 1 fat quarter fabric for inside of journal and appliqué
- 3/8 yard fast2fuse™ or other similar double-sided fusible stiff interfacing
- 1/8 yard Pellon® Wonder-Under® or similar paper-backed fusible web
- coordinating thread for quilting

### OTHER

- Sewing machine and supplies (including thread snipping scissors, if you use them)
- 1/4" foot
- Free motion quilting foot
- piecing thread
- rotary cutter, mat and ruler
